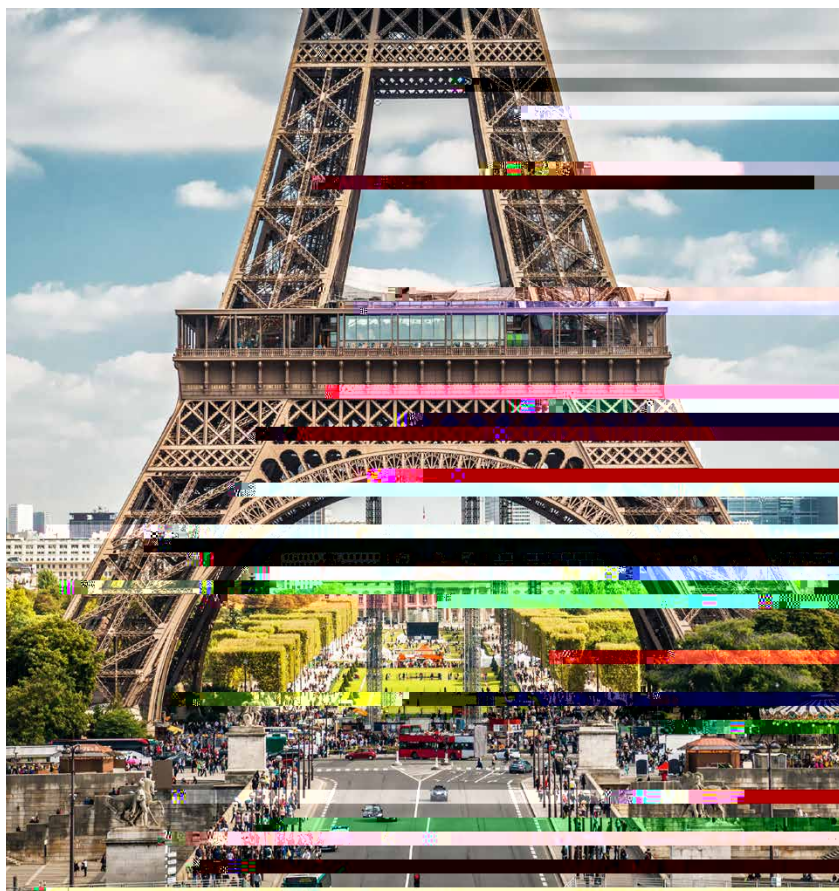
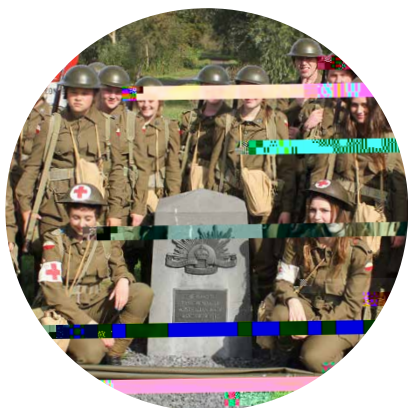


OVERSEAS TRIPS

THE STUDY TRIP TO FRANCE



OPEN TO

Students studying French in Year 9-12 and students who have strong interest in history.

DESCRIPTION

Students stay in Paris, with its famous Eiffel Tower, visit the historic Mont Saint Michel, WW1 Battlefields, D-Day beaches at Normandy as well as travelling to parts of the French countryside. Students will also complete a week long homestay experience with our sister school in Le Havre, living with a French family and immersed in French food, culture and lifestyle.

Option to extend homestay for 2 months

OPEN TO

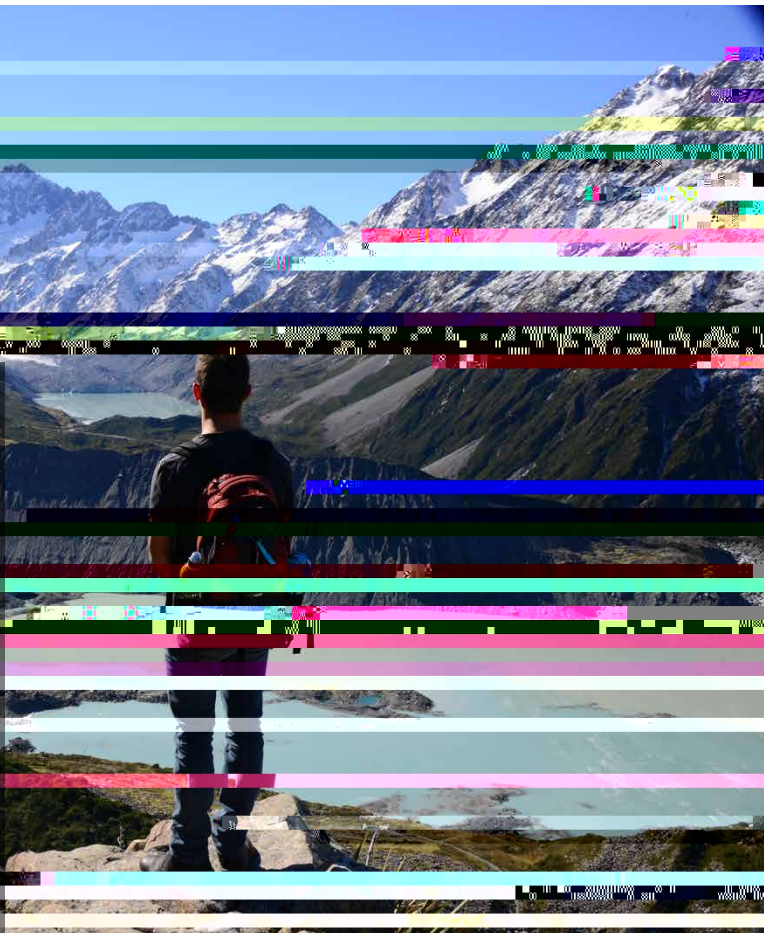
Students in Years 10 - 12, with an interest in Adventure and Outdoor Activities

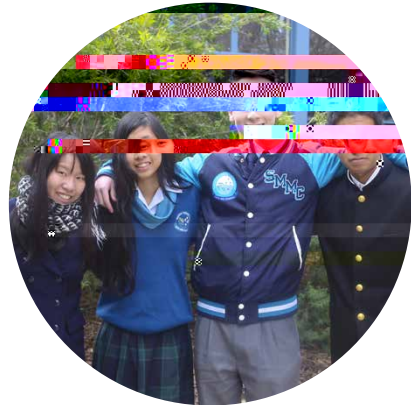

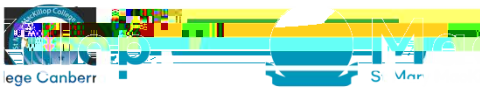
